ORDINANCE NO. 2020-120

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING, AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HELMS & SONS EXCAVATING, FOR THE RESURFACING OF SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL ROADWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to resurface 6th Street from Main Street east to the railroad as well as form the railroad to Eagle Creek, as well as Stanford Parkway from Route 12 to Westfield as roadway substations and additions to the 2020 Resurfacing Project and the 2020 Street Preventative Maintenance Project; and

WHEREAS, Helms & Sons Excavating was the winning bidder and was awarded the City of Findlay's 2020 Resurfacing Project original contract, therefore, the City of Findlay is desirous of waiving formal advertising and bidding and enter into an agreement with Helms & Sons Excavating for them to continue asphalt work on said substitutions and additional work, and;

WHEREAS, no additional funds need to be appropriated for said substitutions and additional work. Said substitutions and additional work exceed the original bid specs and/or was not initially bid, and is greater than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) by the same vendor for the same type of work that will enable Helms & Sons Excavating to complete the asphalt work yet this year before asphalt plants close for the season.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to waive formal advertising and bidding requirements and enter into an agreement with Helms & Sons Excavating for the aforementioned substitutional and additional roadways.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City or Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to waive formal advertising and bidding and enter into an agreement with Helms and Sons Excavating for the aforementioned project to be completed during the 2020 season.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
