## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-130, AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO APPOINT REPRESENTATIVES TO SERVE AS THE GRANT REVIEW BOARD, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FINDLAY'S APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE TO REVIEW AND APPROVE THE APPLICATION PROCESS OF RESILIENCE PROGRAM (aka) CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio is desirous of appointing the following to serve as the Grant Review Board to determine the use of Coronavirus Relief Funds in support of non-profit organizations within the community:

- The Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation representative
- United Way of Hancock County representative
- Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio
- City of Findlay's Appropriations Committee Chair or their designee
- Hancock County Commissioner, or their designee, or a designated County Elected Official
- Hancock County Township Association representative

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio to appoint the aforementioned representatives, or their designee, to serve as the Grant Review Board to determine the use of the Resilience Program (aka Coronavirus Relief Funds), for the City of Findlay Appropriations Committee to approve the Resilience Program application process,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
