MINUTES OF THE FINDLAY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION June 24, 2020

The Civil Service Commission met on Wednesday, June 24, 2020, in Conference Room 1 located on the third floor of the Municipal Building. Those present at the meeting were Civil Service Commission members – Tom Kemp, Chuck Clapper, and Jeff Fort, and Deidre Ramthun, Clerk to the Commission; from the City of Findlay – Don Essex, Human Resources Director; Don Rasmussen, City Law Director; Matt Stoffel, Superintendent, Public Works Department; Dave Honse, Supervisor, Public Works Department; Jeff Betts, Supervisor, Water Treatment Plant; and Jason Phillips, Superintendent, Water Treatment Plant.

A. Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made by Chuck Clapper to approve the minutes from the March 4, 2020 meeting. Said motion was seconded by Jeff Fort, unanimously approved, motion carried and minutes adopted.

B. Deidre Ramthun reported the following:

Unfinished Business:

1. A request was received on March 9, 2020 from Service Director Brian Thomas for certification of one additional name from the Water Meter Reader eligible list to replace the name of Ira Mansfield who exercised his waiver right. One name was certified on March 9, 2020.

A request was received on March 10, 2020 from Service Director Brian Thomas for certification of one additional name from the Water Meter Reader eligible list to replace the name of Beau Veach who exercised his waiver right. One name was certified on March 10, 2020.

Don King V was appointed to the vacant Water Meter Reader position effective May 18, 2020.

A request was received from Safety Director Paul Schmelzer for certification of names from the Police Chief eligible list. Three names were certified on June 2, 2020. Interviews were held on June 18, 2020.

Captain Robert Ring will be promoted to Chief of Police for the City of Findlay effective July 6, 2020.

It was determined that there was no need for discussion of the promotional examination and the Memorandum of Understanding for Chief of Police in reference to the pending vacant Captain position.

New Business:

- 1. A request was received on June 24, 2020 from Safety Director Paul Schmelzer for certification of names from the Police Chief eligible list for the vacant Captain position in the Findlay Police Department.
- 2. A request was received on June 24, 2020 from Safety Director Paul Schmelzer for certification of names from the eligible list for Fire Captain.
- 3. A request was received from Don Essex, Human Resources, Director, to transfer Briar Courtney from a Waterline Maintenance Worker position in the Water Distribution Department to a Public Works Maintenance Worker in the Public Works Department. Don informed the Commission that the Job Descriptions are similar. After brief discussion, a motion was made by Chuck Clapper to accept the transfer. Said motion was seconded by Jeff Fort, and the motion was unanimously carried.

If the vacant Waterline Maintenance Worker position in Water Distribution is to be filled, an open competitive civil service examination will need to be administered.

- 2. The Annual Report of Activities was e-mailed to the State Personnel Board of Review on March 12, 2020.
- The Year-to-Date Budget Report was reviewed.
