ORDINANCE NO. 2021-043

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A TRAFFIC AND FABRICATION SHOP FOR THE CITY OF FINDLAY'S PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT LOCATED ON CORY STREET, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to acquire three (3) parcels of land near the City of Findlay's Public Works Department on Cory Street for the construction of a Traffic and Fabrication Shop as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, total cost of said acquisition of land is not to exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00). An additional ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) is requested for the proposed building's preliminary plans.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated as follows:

FROM:

CIT Fund - Capital Improvements Restricted Account

\$ 40,000,00

TO:

Traffic and Fabrication Shop, Project No. 31912500

\$ 40,000.00

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and/or Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the acquisition of said three (3) parcels of land for the construction of a proposed Traffic and Fabrication Shop, and begin preliminary design.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to acquire said three (3) parcels of land near the City of Findlay's Public Works Department for the construction of a Traffic and Fabrication Shop to be utilized by the City.

WHEREFORE, This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and

approval by the Mayor.
