ORDINANCE NO. 2021-053

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY GRANT APPLICATION(S) TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR THEIR AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of securing a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration Airport Improvement Grant in the estimated amount of eighty-nine thousand forty-six dollars and no cents (\$89,046.00), and;

WHEREAS, said grant along with the City's matching share of zero percent (0%) will be used for all of the design cost associated with the North Apron Rehab Project No. 35210500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to sign the necessary grant applicants, agreements, and other necessary documents for the aforementioned grant from the Federal Aviation Administration.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that reimbursement funds received from the FAA AIP-30 grant may be utilized within the City of Findlay Airport.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
