ORDINANCE NO. 2021-035, AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF A CERTAIN AVENUE (HEREINAFTER REFERED TO AS THE BLISS AVENUE VACATION) IN THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO.

SECTION 1: That the following described avenue be and the same is hereby vacated:

Being a portion of Bliss Avenue; 60 foot wide right-of-way east of Lima Avenue bounded on the south by Lot 8, Block 32 in the Thorp and Andrews West Park Plat and on the east by the former Greenwood Street right-of-way (vacated).

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid vacation is hereby made subject to the preservation of the public utilities right-of-way, in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 723.041 including an easement is reserved for all sanitary and/or storm sewer lines in said vacated right-of-way.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.
