ORDINANCE NO. 2021-060

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDS, FOR THE HAN-GREENWAY TRAIL PHASE 2 PID109009 PROJECT NO. 31993800, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Service-Safety Director, and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a project agreement for Federal Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds for the HAN-Greenway Trail Phase 2 PID109009 Project No. 31993800.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enter into said agreement so that ODOT funds for Federal Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds may be utilized.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage

and approval by the Mayor.
