MINUTES

ATTENDANCE

Members Present: Mayor Christina Muryn, Don Rasmussen, Jeff Wobser.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve minutes of the February 3, 2021, meeting as presented, by Law Director Rasmussen, second by Councilman Wobser. Motion passed 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Year-To-Date Collections: Price stated that the collections through April 30, 2021, were up 13.541%. Price stated that collections are coming in normally based over the last five years. Last year didn't end up terrible.

Collections, Estimates, Delinquencies: Price stated that past due collections through April 2021 are up 13.725% over last year; court cases are down .3% over last year; wage garnishments are up 103.7% over last year due to not being able to file any new wage garnishments April-July, 2020. After tax season focus more on delinquencies.

Legal Actions in Process and Contemplated: Law Director Rasmussen stated that they have been filing as they receive, doing more and more wage garnishments.

Approval of Business Forms: Mayor Muryn stated that overall there are minor changes. The main change is related to language around HB 197-municipal tax issue. They dismissed the court case. Price stated that it looks like they may appeal the ruling. Mayor Muryn stated the biggest issue is that they are not looking at retroactive refunds. If they do any change for work from home in the future it would be date certain in the future and it would not be retroactive. Will continue to watch.

Wobser stated that for the sake of continuity, it may be good to have consistency of format across all forms and fillable forms. Nothing that needs changed today.

Motion to approve the business forms as presented by Mayor Muryn, second by Law Director Rasmussen. Motion passed 3-0.
