

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 071

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VILLAGE OF JENERA FOR SERVICES TO ADMINISTER, ENFORCE, AND COLLECT TAXES LEVIED BY JENERA UNDER THEIR VILLAGE INCOME TAX ON CERTAIN INCOMES OF RESIDENTS, NON-RESIDENTS, NET PROFIT OF RESIDENTS, AND NET PROFITS OF NON-RESIDENT BUSINESS ENTITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAID VILLAGE INCOME TAX ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Jenera, Ohio desires to have the Income Tax Department of the City of Findlay administer its income tax ordinance and any complementing rules and regulations effective January 1, 2022, and;

WHEREAS, This Council hereby desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an Agreement to effectuate said agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Jenera for services to administer, enforce, and collect taxes levied by Jenera under their Village Income Tax Ordinance on certain incomes of residents, non-residents, net profits of residents, and net profits of non-resident business entities in accordance with said Ordinance.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enact said Ordinance so that this agreement may be entered into and be in effect by January 1, 2022,


WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
