ORDINANCE NO. 2021-102

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SCOTT BASINGER TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES OF FILING GARNISHMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY INCOME TAX DEPARTMENT IN FINDLAY MUNICIPAL COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay be and she is hereby authorized to waive the formal advertising and bidding process, pursuant to §735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, and enter into a contract with Scott Basinger to continue to provide legal services of filing garnishments on behalf of the City of Findlay Income Tax Department in Findlay Municipal Court.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason, it is immediately necessary to authorize said waiving of formal advertising and bidding requirements and enter into a contract so that Scott Basinger may continue to provide legal services to the City of Findlay.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage

and approval by the Mayor.
