ORDINANCE NO. 2021-107

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE-SAFETY OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO EXTEND THE CURRENT CONTRACT FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE COMBINATION OF THE HANCOCK COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF FINDLAY HEALTH DEPARTMENT UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the aforementioned contract expires December 31, 2021, and it is necessary to extend said the current contract until December 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, the City's annual commitment of three hundred forty-nine thousand three hundred twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$349,312.50) for continuation of said services will be included in the General Expense budget for 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service-Safety of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to extend said current contract for services provided by the combination of the Hancock County General Health District and the City of Findlay Health Department until December 31, 2022.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to extend said contract so that current Hancock Public Health services may be extended until December 31, 2022.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
