## **ORDINANCE NO. 2021-121**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER'S GRANT (AFG), ALONG WITH THE CITY OF FINDLAY'S TEN PERCENT (10%) MATCH, TO REPLACE SECTIONS OF FIRE HOSE AND MOBILE AND PORTABLE RADIOS FOR THE FINDLAY FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Director of Service-Safety of the City of Findlay, Ohio to file an application for an AFG grant, along with the City of Findlay's matching ten percent (10%) to be used for the replace fire equipment with the Findlay's Fire Department, and;

WHEREAS, upon approval of said grant, Council desires to authorize the Service-Safety Director, and the Auditor of the City of Findlay, Ohio to sign the necessary grant agreement with AFG for said replacements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to file an application for an AFG grant, along with the City of Findlay's ten percent (10%) match, to replace various items within the Findlay Fire Department.

SECTION 2: That upon the grant award, the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents with the Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighter's Grant for the replacement of various items within the Findlay Fire Department.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the filing of said grant application so a grant agreement may be secured forthwith, and executed so that various items within the Findlay Fire Department may be replaced;

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
