

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-124


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO APPLY FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDS AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE HAN-GREENWAY TRAIL PHASE III, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to enter into agreements for the HAN-Greenway Trail Phase III.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enter into said agreements so that Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds may be utilized.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
