

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO APPLY FOR ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION AND THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AVIATION FOR ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of securing a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the North Apron Rehab project, and is seeking authorization to submit a grant application to the FAA and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Aviation for additional construction funds, and;

WHEREAS, the City's matching share will be five percent (5%) of the total construction costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to apply for additional grant funds from the FAA and ODOT Aviation, and enter into grant agreement(s) and other necessary documents for the aforementioned grant funds from the Federal Aviation Administration and the Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is necessary to authorize the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio to apply for grant funding from the Federal Aviation Administration and the Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation, and enter into a grant agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration and the Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
