

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-030

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HELMS AND SONS EXCAVATING, INC. TO REPAIR A STORM CULVERT UNDERNEATH BROAD AVENUE, APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Service-Safety Director, and or City Engineer of the City of Findlay be and they are hereby authorized to waive the formal advertising and bidding process, pursuant to §735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, and enter into a contract with Helms and Sons Excavating, Inc. to repair a storm culvert underneath Broad Avenue.


SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated and transferred:

FROM:	Sewer Fund	\$ 55,000.00
TO:	Broad Avenue Storm Culvert, <i>Project No. 35521800</i>	\$ 55,000.00

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason, it is immediately necessary to authorize said waiving of formal advertising and bidding requirements and enter into a contract with Helms and Sons Excavating, Inc., and appropriate and transfer funds, so that they may repair a storm culvert underneath Broad Avenue.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
