

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-022**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO SIGN THE NECESSARY PAPERWORK TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF MARATHON PETROLEUM COMPANY LP'S SOLAR PANEL FIELD THAT WAS BUILT ON THE CITY OF FINDLAY'S WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CENTER'S CAMPUS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay provided six (6) acres of land for Marathon Petroleum Company LP to build a solar panel field on the City's Water Pollution Control Center's campus in 2012, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay has experienced a large electric energy savings from said solar panel field that still provides energy to the City's Water Pollution Control Center, and;

WHEREAS, Marathon Petroleum Company LP has completed their objective research and would now like to transfer ownership to the City of Findlay which would continue to provide a benefit to the City of Findlay exceeding the required maintenance costs of the solar panel field.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio to sign the necessary paperwork to transfer ownership of Marathon's Petroleum Company's LP solar panel field built on City of Findlay land.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
