

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-032

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF MS HYPER-V WITH VMWARE EQUIPMENT, APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Service-Safety Director, and or City Engineer of the City of Findlay be and they are hereby authorized to waive the formal advertising and bidding process pursuant to §735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code and enter into a contract or contracts for the replacement of the MS Hyper-V with VMWare equipment, and to appropriate and transfer funds.

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:


FROM:	CIT Fund – Capital Improvements Restricted Account	\$ 51,000.00
TO:	Computer Services #21009000-other	\$ 51,000.00

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason, it is immediately necessary to authorize entering into a contract or contracts for the replacement of MS Hyper-V with VMWare equipment, as well as appropriate and transfer funds, to alleviate current server issues.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
