ORDINANCE NO. 2022-049, AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR, AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RQAW ARCHITECTURE FOR THE DESIGN OF THE COMMUNITY ALTERNATIVE SENTENCING CENTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay sent out Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to consultants to design the Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CASC) Facility with RQAW Architecture being selected from said RFQ process, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to move forward with said CASC facility, therefore, authorizing RQAW Architecture to provide the design work; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Service-Safety Director, and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with RQAW Architecture for the design work of said CASC Facility.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay. Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize said contract with RQAW Architecture so that the design phase of the aforementioned project may begin.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage

and approval by the Mayor.
