

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-056

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR, AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HOHENBRINK EXCAVATING INC., FOR THE CHERRY STREET STORM SEWER PROJECT NO. 35524100, APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to utilize the catch basin for the drainage of a new parking lot south of the railroad tracks on Main Street, ensuring that storm water flows to the City of Findlay's storm sewer system, and;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


FROM: Sewer Fund-Stormwater Restricted Account \$50,000.00
TO: Cherry Street Storm Sewer Project No. 35524100 \$ 50,000.00

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Service-Safety Director, and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to waive all formal advertising and bidding and enter into a contract with Hohenbrink Excavating Inc. for the Cherry Street Storm Sewer, Project No. 35524100.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize said waiving of advertising and bidding and enter into a contract with Hohenbrink Excavating Inc so that the aforementioned project may begin.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
