

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-075**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO SIGN ANY APPLICABLE GRANT AGREEMENT(S) OR RELATED DOCUMENTS FOR THE FINDLAY-HANCOCK COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT PROGRAM (THE MADELINE THOMAS SCHNEIDER FUND), APPROPRIATION FUNDS THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay has been awarded a grant from the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation grant program to be used toward a mural on the Martin Luther King overpass in downtown Findlay, Ohio, and;

WHEREAS, said grant is funded through the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation whose funding source is The Madeleine Thomas Schneider Fund, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:



SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and she is hereby authorized to sign any applicable grant agreement(s) or related documents for Community Foundation Grant program.

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	Community Foundation Grant (The Madeleine Thomas Schneider Fund)	\$ 15,000.00
TO:	MLK Mural #31924800	\$ 15,000.00

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the signing of said grant agreement(s) or related documents so that this grant agreement may be secured forthwith and executed so that these grant funds may be utilized for their intended purposes;

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
