## ORDINANCE NO. 2022-085, AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) WITH WARNER BUICK-GMC FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) FIRE DEPARTMENT UTILITY PICKUP TRUCK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to replace one (1) Fire Department utility pickup truck, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to waive formal advertising and bidding requirements and enter into a contract(s) for the purchase of replacement Fire Department utility pickup trucks, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to waive all formal advertising and bidding and enter into a contract(s) with Warner Buick-GMC for the purchase of one (1) replacement Fire Department utility pickup truck.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize said waiving of advertising and bidding and enter into a contract(s) with Warner Buick-GMC so that a replacement utility pickup truck to be utilized by the City of Findlay Fire Department may be purchased.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
