ORDINANCE NO. 2022-107

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREMENT WITH THE FINDLAY-HANCOCK COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE FUNDS TO PURCHASE CHRISTMAS TREE ORNAMENTS AND DECORATING SUPPLIES TO BE PLACED ON THE CITY OF FINDLAY CHRISTMAS TREE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay, Ohio is desirous to enter into a grant agreement with the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "THE FOUNDATION") in order to receive grant awarded funds to purchase Christmas tree ornaments and decorating supplies for the Findlay community to decorate and place on the City of Findlay Christmas tree, and;

WHEREAS, THE FOUNDATION has awarded a one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500.00) grant to the City of Findlay to cover the costs of said ornaments and decorating supplies to be decorated by the Findlay community and then placed on the City of Findlay Christmas tree to be located in Dorney Plaza.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and she is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with THE FOUNDATION in order to received awarded funds to purchase Christmas tree ornaments to be decorated by the Findlay community to be placed on the City of Findlay Christmas tree.

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM: Community Foundation Grant (The Madeleine Thomas Schneider Fund) \$ 1,500.00

TO: Service-Safety Director #21020000-other \$1,500.00

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the entering into a grant agreement with the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation, appropriating awarded grant funds thereto, so that ornaments and decorating supplies may be purchased.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
