

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-135

AN ORDINANCE DE-APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, construction of the Blanchard/Lincoln project was completed in late 2021 with funds remaining in the project; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to de-appropriate the excess funds back into the CIT Fund so that they can be utilized for other projects.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby de-appropriated and transferred:

FROM:	HAN-Blanchard/Lincoln Bike Lanes, <i>Project No. 32876000</i>	\$ 55,901.93
TO:	CIT Fund – Capital Improvements Restricted Account	\$ 55,901.93

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to de-appropriate and transfer the aforementioned funds so that unneeded appropriated funds may be de-appropriated and transferred so that they are available for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Findlay, Ohio,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
