

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-146

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH W. W. WILLIAMS – TOLEDO LOCATED IN LEMOYNE, OHIO, FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO FIRE ENGINE 1 UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF FINDLAY FIRE DEPARTMENT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THERETO, AND DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to immediately repair a cylinder head, as well as the EGR cooler of Fire Engine 1 so that it can continue to be utilized by the City of Findlay Fire Department, and;

WHEREAS, a purchase order was already in place for planned repairs to said Fire Engine 1, but that additional problems were found that are immediately necessary to be repaired, thus necessitating the need for additional funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That a real and present emergency does exist for the aforementioned repairs necessitating that the Mayor and/or Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the emergency repairs to the existing Fire Engine 1.

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	General Fund	\$ 17,000.00	
TO:	Fire Department #21014000-other		\$ 17,000.00

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason a real and present emergency currently necessitating the immediate repairs to said Fire Engine 1,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
