Arbor Day 2022: Jane continues to meet with Chamberlin Hill School staff, working on details. The date change allows the Mayor to attend May 6. They have suggested a Kentucky Coffeetree for planting; the school will stake location, Public Works Dept. will call 811 to check underground utilities and then dig the hole / set tree in place Thursday May 5. Jane will check more tree options from school then get with Dave / AJ to confirm availability and ordering. Jane will check on tools to bring & water buckets. Mayor will have the Proclamation to read at 2 pm program. Invitations will be sent out by school, additions to the invites were discussed that Jane will coordinate with the School.

New Business

- FSTC Resolutions Review Brian distributed 2 Resolutions from 2017 that were approved but never dated and put out for the public to see (website documents). Issues came up when the list of Prohibited Trees (Resolution 2017-1) could not be found, along with Resolution 2017-2 on a Tree Replacement Program. Kathy Launder helped Tim find them in the Minutes of the January 3, 2017 meeting where they were approved. Tim gave history of the committee work back in 2016 when the Tree Ordinance was revised / replaced and Resolutions on these 2 issues were prepared and approved. Brian asked they be reviewed for further discussion. Jane, Tom & Tim will check for a list of recommended trees to plant and other possible trees to add to the Prohibited List. AJ suggested that Black Walnut as a nuisance along with Sweet Gum nuts a hazard be added.
- **FSTC Media Update** Brian and Kellie met to plan potential City website and Facebook postings for the Mayor's office about Findlay's tree program including Arbor Day and Tree City USA Awards event.
