Welcome: Brian (Chairman) thanked everyone for attending.

Minutes: Minutes were distributed for March, April & May meetings and reviewed with no changes. Haley moved, Jane seconded motion to approve, vote unanimous.

Financial Report: Brian distributed report by Robin Schey dated May 2022, reviewed, and filed.

- Brian distributed copies of a DRAFT Tree Ordinance that has been completed to date. Brian has already met to review with Dave, AJ and Eric from Zoning. Brian will work with Kellie Bibler over the summer for ways we can do a better job.
