ORDINANCE NO. 2023-067

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO APPLY FOR FUNDS THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (USDOT) FOR THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT PROGRAM AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR THE HAN-LAKE CASCADES AND SIXTH STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to apply for funds through the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) for the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program and enter into agreements for the HAN-Lake Cascades and Sixth Street Improvements.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to apply for and enter into said agreements so that funds from the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program may be obtained and utilized to extend the existing multi-use trail on Lima Avenue south to Lake Cascades.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage

and approval by the Mayor.
