

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-081, AS AMENDED


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT(S) TO FARM APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE (181) ACRES IN THE VICINITY OF THE AIRPORT, APPROXIMATELY SIXTY-FOUR (64) ACRES IN THE VICINITY OF THE RESERVOIRS, AND APPROXIMATELY TWENTY-THREE (23) ACRES AT THE CARLIN STREET LOCATION, ALL OWNED BY THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, WITH ANNUAL OPT-OUT PROVISIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a lease agreement(s) for farmland areas owned by the City of Findlay, for a period of three (3) year beginning calendar year 2024 with annual opt-out provisions.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to secure said bids so that said lease agreement(s) may be entered into prior to the 2024 spring planting.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
