

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-140

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FINDLAY-HANCOCK COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE FUNDS FROM THEIR PRESIDENT'S DISCRETIONARY GRANT #24266 PROGRAM, TO BE UTILIZED FOR COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES BETWEEN THE CITY OF FINDLAY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay, Ohio is desirous to accept and enter into a grant agreement with the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "THE FOUNDATION") in order to receive grant awarded funds in support of community engagement activities between the City of Findlay Police Department and the residents of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and;


WHEREAS, THE FOUNDATION has awarded a five thousand five hundred dollars (\$5,000.00) grant to the City of Findlay Police Department with no City match required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to accept and enter into a grant agreement with THE FOUNDATION in order to receive awarded funds to be utilized for community engagement activities between the City of Findlay Police Department and the residents of the City of Findlay, Ohio.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the accepting and entering into a grant agreement with the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation President's Discretionary Grant program, so that funds may be utilized within the City of Findlay Police Department for community engagement activities between the City of Findlay Police Department and the residents of the City of Findlay, Ohio.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
