

# ORDINANCE NO. 2024-018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND/OR CITY ENGINEER OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS WHERE REQUIRED AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF PRECISION APPROACH PATH INDICATOR (PAPI)S AND RUNWAY END IDENTIFIER LIGHTS (REIL)S AT THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO AIRPORT FOR THE RUNWAY 7/25 NAV-AID REHAB, PROJECT NO. 35234500, APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Service-Safety Director and/or City Engineer of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the replacement of Precision Approach Path Indicator (PAPI)s and Runway End Identifier Lights (REIL)s on Runway 7/25 at the City of Findlay, Ohio Airport as part of the awarded Runway 7/25 Nav-Aid Rehab, Project No. 35234500 Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation Grant funds.

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated and transferred:

FROM:	ODOT Aviation Grant (M24-13)	\$ 465,880.00
TO:	Runway 7/25 Nav-Aid Rehab, <i>Project No. 35234500</i>	\$ 465,880.00
FROM:	CIT Fund – Capital Improvement Restricted Account	\$ 24,520.00
TO:	Runway 7/25 Nav-Aid Rehab, <i>Project No. 35234500</i>	\$ 24,520.00

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio; and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to advertise for bids where required and enter into contracts for said replacement PAPIs and REILs on Runway 7/25 at the City of Findlay, Ohio Airport, as well as appropriate and transfer said funds so that the aforementioned project may proceed,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
