

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-029

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG) FOR FIREFIGHTER TRAINING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to file an application with the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG), utilizing the AFG and local ten percent (10%) match funds, for Firefighter training.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the filing of said grant application so that a grant agreement may be secured forthwith and executed in order for grant funds to be utilized for Firefighter training within the City of Findlay Fire Department;

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
