This form is used for filing a request to have a criminal case sealed. It is strongly suggested that you speak with an attorney or do research on your own to verify you are eligible for this process BEFORE filing the application. Additional information regarding the Sealing/Expungement process can be found at <u>OhioLegalHelp.org.</u>

Download the form and type in the Case Number you are seeking to have sealed. You will need to fill out your name, current address and all other applicable information. If you are filing on multiple cases, please use a separate form for each case.

Once the form is filled out you will then need to print it and sign your name on the signature line.

The application <u>and filing fee</u> must then be filed with the Clerk's Office in one of the following ways:

- 1) Hand delivered to the Clerk's Office.
- 2) Mail the motion to the Clerk's Office.

Please call the Clerk's Office at 419-424-7141 to find out the current filing fee. The filing fee may be paid using cash, check, money order, credit card or online payment. Online payments can be submitted at <u>www.GovPayNow.com</u>. Please use the option to apply to fines and costs and put "Filing Fee for Expungement" in the comments box to help with processing.

Once the application is filed it will be set for hearing 60 - 90 days out. A hearing notice will be sent to the address listed on the application. If you have not received a notice and a few days have passed since you filed your application please contact the Court at 419-424-7144.
