RESOLUTION NO. 027-2015

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ENACTMENT OF STATE ISSUE 3 PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT GRANTING THE EXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO CULTIVATE, MARKET, AND SELL RECREATIONAL AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA TO A FEW SELECT CORPORATIONS, AND TO ALLOW ALL OHIO ADULTS OVER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE (21) TO GROW AND USE MARIJUANA.

WHEREAS, State Issue 3, which proposes a constitutional amendment granting the exclusive right to cultivate, market, and sell recreational and medical marijuana to a few select corporations, and to allow all Ohio adults over the age of twenty-one (21) to grow and use marijuana, will appear on the ballot in the general election held on the 3rd day of November, 2015, and;

WHEREAS, this council, the City of Findlay, and the Findlay City School Board of Education stand together in strong opposition to State Issue 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That this Council, the City of Findlay, and the Findlay City School Board of Education strongly oppose the passage of State Issue 3 and advocate to the voters of the City of Findlay and Hancock County, Ohio to vote **NO** on State Issue 3.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest

period provided by law.
