ORDINANCE NO. 2016-017

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH TAP FEES FOR THE WEST PARK SANITARY SEWER PROJECT #35632100, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Council desires to authorize the City to provide sanitary sewer services to properties in the West Park Addition that are currently serviced by septic tanks and leach fields, and:

SECTION 2: No laterals exist to connect to, therefore, the City of Findlay will provide them to the right-of-way with property owners being responsible for connection to their house sewer with the following payment options:

- Tap fees waived if legally connected by December 31, 2016 or
 - \$100/year (\$600 ÷ 6 years) if not paid by December 31, 2016
 - Impact \$46.39 (\$270.00/6 years)
 - Capacity \$41.58 (\$242.00/6 years)
 - General \$12.03 (\$70.00/6 years)

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize aforementioned tap fees so that this project may proceed expediously.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage and approval by the Mayor.
