

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-037

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ALTER THE CORY STREET TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PLAN (TAP), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is currently planning for a Transportation Alternative Plan (TAP) in conjunction with ODOT for Main Street and Cory Street, and;

WHEREAS, Cory Street is currently planned to be changed to one-way traffic in a northbound direction to allow for a dedicated bike lane, and;



WHEREAS, Council has the ability to modify the plans for Cory Street without jeopardizing the funding for the TAP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay be and he is hereby authorized to alter the current Transportation Alternative Plan to maintain current two-way traffic configuration on Cory Street and adding bicycle sharrow lanes in each direction.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to alter said plans so that the current Cory Street TAP project may proceed expeditiously,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
