

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-011

AN ORDINANCE DE-APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2015-001 appropriated more funds to the Enforcement Educational fund than was statutorily allowed; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to de-appropriate the excess funds.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby de-appropriated:


FROM:	Enforcement/Education #22075000-other	\$ 6,400.00
TO:	Enforcement/Education Fund	\$ 6,400.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to de-appropriate aforementioned funds so that statutory allowable amounts may be maintained, and so that unneeded appropriated funds may be de-appropriated and be available for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Findlay, Ohio,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
