

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO APPLY FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM AND TO SIGN THE NECESSARY AGREEMENT OR AGREEMENTS WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR FUNDS TO BE USED FOR THE UPGRADING OF ALL DEFICIENT CURB RAMPS WITHIN A ONE MILE RADIUS AROUND GLENWOOD MIDDLE SCHOOL IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH AMERICAN DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) STANDARDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio to apply for the Safe Routes to School Program Grant and to sign the necessary agreement or agreements with ODOT for funds to be used for the upgrading of all deficient curb ramps within a one mile radius around Glenwood Middle School all in accordance with ADA standards.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and she is hereby authorized to apply for the Safe Routes to School Program Grant and to sign the necessary agreement or agreements with the ODOT for the upgrading of all deficient curb ramps around Glenwood Middle School.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize the applying of said grant so that aforementioned curb ramp upgrades may be made on an expedited basis;

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
