

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-024

AN ORDINANCE DE-APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Nos. 2014-078 and 2014-079 appropriated more funds to the 2014 Resurfacing Program fund than was necessary; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Council to de-appropriate the excess funds in order that they may be available for future capital projects.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby de-appropriated:


FROM:	2014 Resurfacing Program #32842100	\$ 200,000.00
TO:	CIT Capital Improvements	\$ 200,000.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to de-appropriate aforementioned funds so that unneeded appropriated funds may be de-appropriated and be available for other capital expenditures of the City of Findlay, Ohio,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
