

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-068

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	General Fund (HWE donation to FFD)	\$ 200.00
TO:	Fire Department #21014000-other	\$ 200.00
FROM:	OEPA grant	\$ 30,000.00
TO:	Cyanotoxin Testing Equipment #35754600	\$ 30,000.00
FROM:	ODH Child & Family Services Grant	\$ 50,589.00
TO:	Health Dept Child & Family Health Services #31955500	\$ 50,589.00
FROM:	General Fund (UF donation)	\$ 1,500.00
TO:	Health Dept Project D.A.W.N. Project #31955500	\$ 1,500.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that donations to the Findlay Fire Department may be utilized, so that grant funds received to the Water Treatment Plant may be utilized, so that contributions to the City Health Department may be utilized,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
