

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-099

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR THE REPAIR OF THE BLAINE AVENUE AND ELYRIA STREET WATERLINES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THERETO, AND DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to the serious disrepair of said waterlines, it is the desire of this Council to authorize the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio to waive formal advertising and bidding requirements, hire a contractor or contractors to replace said waterlines, and appropriate funds for said replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:



SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to waive formal advertising and bidding requirements and enter into a contract or contracts for the repair of said waterlines.

SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM: Water Fund	\$ 100,000.00
TO: Blaine Avenue Waterline Replacement #35752100	\$ 50,000.00
TO: Elyria Street Waterline Replacement #35752000	\$ 50,000.00

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be a real and present emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that waterlines for the above locations may be replaced,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
