ORDINANCE NO. 2015-113

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO AMEND SECTION IV, PARAGRAPH 7 OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE COMBINATION OF THE HANCOCK COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF FINDLAY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Section IV, paragraph 7 of the Contract for the Combination of the Hancock County General Health District and the City of Findlay Health Department Agreement reads as follows:

7. The Carry over balance necessary for the operation of the Combined General Health District from January 1, 2016 until the first settlement of tax revenues in March, 2016 shall be contributed by the DAC and City of Findlay in the same manner as the allocation of costs as set forth in Section IV herein. The carryover total will be determined by calculating the actual sum available to the DAC as representing 42.5% of the "necessary carryover" and the City of Findlay contributing the remaining 57.5%. Ex. If the sum available to the DAC as carryover is \$42,500.00 the total necessary carryover sum will be assumed to be \$100,000.00, therefore requiring the City to contribute \$57,500.00.

Be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

7. The Carry over balance necessary for the operation of the Combined General Health District shall be contributed by the DAC and City of Findlay in the same manner as the allocation of costs as set forth in Section IV herein. The carryover total will be determined by calculating the actual sum available to the DAC as representing 42.5% of the "necessary carryover" and the City of Findlay contributing the remaining 57.5%. Ex. If the sum available to the DAC as carryover is \$42,500.00 the total necessary carryover sum will be assumed to be \$100,000.00, therefore requiring the City to contribute \$57,500.00.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary for the City of Findlay to contribute the "necessary carryover" so that the combined General Health District will have the necessary funds to operate.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
