

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-018

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	Medical Reserve Corps Grant	\$	3,500.00
TO:	MRC Grant #31992400	\$	3,500.00
FROM:	Capital Improvements - CIT	\$	205,000.00
TO:	N Main St/Lexington Ave intersection <i>project #32832500</i>	\$	90,000.00
TO:	Crystal Ave/N Blanchard St Intersection <i>project #32832400</i>	\$	115,000.00
FROM:	Water Fund (Insurance Proceeds)	\$	866.73
TO:	Water/Sewer Billing Department #25072000- <i>other</i>	\$	866.73
FROM:	Capital Improvements – CIT	\$	55,570.00
TO:	Street Department #22040000- <i>other</i>	\$	55,570.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that the Health Department may continue to develop and maintain an official Medical Reserve Corps in Hancock County, so that needed repairs to departmental vehicles may be made, so that aforementioned projects may proceed expeditiously, so that funds received from the City's insurance company for repair of a pick up truck from an accident may be utilized, and so that a replacement dump truck for the Street Department may be purchased,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
