

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-031, AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	ODOT	\$ 592,000.00
FROM:	CIT – Capital Improvement	\$ 148,000.00
FROM:	Hancock County Commissioners	\$ 7,069.26
TO:	ODOT FY14 Resurfacing <i>project #32832300</i>	\$ 747,069.26
FROM:	Capital Improvements – CIT	\$ 162,000.00
TO:	Curb Replacement on East Sandusky Street and North Main Street, <i>project #32842100</i>	\$ 162,000.00
FROM:	Capital Improvements – CIT	\$ 105,000.00
TO:	N. Main St/Bigelow Ave Intersection, <i>project #32831200</i>	\$ 105,000.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that resurfacing and curb replacement projects may begin, and so that signal poles may be installed,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
