ORDINANCE NO. 2014-055

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2014-023 OF THE CODIFIED ORDNANCES OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2014-023 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Findlay, Ohio was adopted during the April 15, 2014 City Council meeting to accept the street right-of-way dedication as shown on the Interstate West right-of-way dedication plat, but now the petitioner has decided not to proceed with this project, therefore Ordinance No. 2014-023 is no longer needed and should be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Codified Ordinance No. 2014-023 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to repeal Ordinance No. 2014-023 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Findlay, Ohio as it is no longer needed.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and Director of Public Safety.
