

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-058

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE HANCOCK COUNTY ENGINEER TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES TO THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO ON A TEMPORARY BASIS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Service-Safety Director is desirous of entering into a contract with the Hancock County Engineer to allow their employee Steve Wilson, P.E., P.S. to provide engineering services to the City of Findlay on a temporary basis due to a recent resignation within the Engineering Department.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Hancock County Engineer to provide engineering services to the City of Findlay on a temporary basis.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize said contract so that said engineering services may commence immediately due to said recent resignation within the engineering department.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
