

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-059

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:


FROM:	General Fund (contribution)	\$ 2,331.00
TO:	Parks Department #21034000-other	\$ 2,331.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that grant funds received from the Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation and contributions from the Sherman Park residents may be utilized for the Sherman Park Neighborhoods project,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
