ORDINANCE NO. 2014-061

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN AVENUE (HEREINAFTER REFERED TO AS EAST MEADE AVENUE VACATION) IN THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to Council for vacating a portion of East Meade Avenue from the westerly right-of-way line of France Street to the east line of the north-south alley, as platted in the North View Subdivision for Lots 7 through 14, in Block 7, and Lots 15 through 22 in Block 1 as set forth herein, and:
