AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	Capital Improvements – CIT	\$ 2,000.00
TO:	Howard Run Ditch Cleaning <i>project #32549500</i>	\$ 2,000.00
FROM:	Capital Improvements	\$ 25,000.00
TO:	CUBE Evaporative Condenser <i>project #31949400</i>	\$ 25,000.00
FROM:	General Fund (Hancock-Wood Electric grant)	\$ 5,447.00
TO:	Safe Kids <i>Project #31924200</i>	\$ 5,447.00
FROM:	Ohio Environmental Education and Charitable Trust Grant	\$ 14,470.00
TO:	Stormwater Management Plan – MS4 <i>project #32566300</i>	\$ 14,470.00
FROM:	General Fund (insurance proceeds)	\$ 1,348.79
TO:	Health Department <i>#21030000-other</i>	\$ 1,348.79

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that the Howard Run Ditch Cleaning project may proceed, so that the CUBE Condenser project may continue, so that child safety efforts through the Safe Kids Program may continue, and so that monies received from aforementioned grant and an insurance settlement may be utilized,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
