

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-075

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 195.15 AND 195.16 OF ORDINANCE NOS. 1994-105 AND 2002-009 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1994-105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Findlay, Ohio, adopted December 6, 1994, and Ordinance No. 2002-009, adopted on February 5, 2002 to allocate funds to the Community Development Foundation (CDF), and the Arts Partnership, and;


WHEREAS, these allocations are no longer allocated and should therefore be repealed as contrary to current practice.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Sections 195.15 and 195.16 of Codified Ordinance Nos. 1995-105 and 2002-009 be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to repeal Ordinance Nos. 1994-105 and 2002-009 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Findlay, Ohio as they are in conflict with current practice.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and Director of Public Safety.
