ORDINANCE NO. 2014-088

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM: Ohio Department of Public Safety – EMS grant \$ 1,500.00

TO: Fire Department #21014000-other \$ 1,500.00

FROM: General Fund \$ 3,764.30

TO: General Expense #21010000-other \$ 3,764.30

FROM: Sewer Fund \$48,000.00

Equipment Replacement Restricted Account

TO: WPC #25061000-other \$ 48,000.00

FROM: Capital Improvements – CIT \$ 35,000.00

TO: E Sandusky St/East St Intersection \$ 35,000.00

Upgrade Project #32840700

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that funds received from the Ohio Department of Public Safety — Division of EMS may be utilized, so that Christmas lights may be installed on downtown Findlay light poles, so that a conveyor for the Water Pollution Control Center may be purchased, and so that traffic signal poles may be purchased,

passage and approval by the Mayor.
